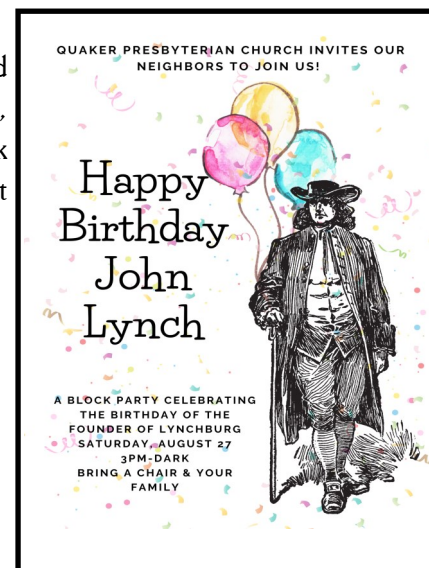
PLEASE REMEMBER to turn off or silence your cell phone prior to the beginning of worship services.
