

*CALL TO WORSHIP Grace Jacob, Liturgist
L: If there is anything we need to learn, it is to listen
P: In the midst of so many words telling us who “we” are and who “they” are
we can start to believe that God is silent
L: The voices around us direct us and misdirect us and sell us all manner of
things that are not true.
P: But, when we still the noise around us and within us, take the time to sit at
your feet and embrace the humility required to hear we discover that you
whisper still.
L: You whisper within us and through our neighbors, in cries of need, and the
silence of grief.
P: Once we have heard your Word, we will know how to live the truth you
have so gently spoken.
