\*PRAYER OF CONFESSION Skip Wodke, Liturgist  
Loving and Merciful God, we know the whole law is summed up in the single commandment to love our neighbor as ourselves. Yet we create fences around ourselves to keep neighbors outside and tell ourselves we have no responsibility. We create obstacles and barriers that keep people on the margins. We ridicule and attack those with different viewpoints. When Jesus calls us to follow him, we find every excuse to go another way. God, you have called us to be one even as you are one. Forgive us for the disunity we have harbored and make us one. We ask you, O God to open our minds and hearts to the challenge and invitation to model your perfect example of love. In Jesus’ name we pray. Amen.
