At it's May meeting the Session approved:

- Collecting the Pentecost Offering.

- Children's Worship will begin on Rally Day, providing there are enough volunteers to effectively run the program.
- Continuing to serve Communion via the premade kits.
- The Cress Family request to use the Fellowship Hall.

All changes to the Worship Service are subject to change based on State and Federal Mandates.

At the June meeting, the Session approved:
