Meal Packing Event October 3

Rise Against Hunger is an agency supplementing national & international efforts to assist in direct food relief for the hungry. The agency helps organize an event in which the congregation will be involved in filling 10,000 bags of rice. One bag has a serving size for six meals.

Members of the church will have the opportunity to come together for packing the bags for two hours after worship on **October 3**. That Sunday is World Communion Sunday and it is fitting for us to have emphasis on worldwide Hunger needs.

We will need about 40 people (the more the merrier) to help set up the event, fill the bags and clean up afterwards. Quaker Memorial always comes through with the support needed.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Thanks to all of you at QMPC, we are able to continue supporting our missions both local and international. This Fall, we will participate in two projects:

- Food For Thought: This is our second year to participate in collecting prepackaged, nutritious snacks for children in Lynchburg who may not have much food outside of school hours. Park View Mission's Backpack program, Food for Thought, packs meal bags for children to take home on the weekends. We will collect the entire month of **November**. Watch for the collection bin around Nov. 1.
- 2. ParkView also has a program that allows people to "shop" for items needed when making a new home. Most needed are new or gently used kitchen essentials; anything you would find in a kitchen, but no larger than a microwave. These items can be left at the church and will be delivered to ParkView.
